## CONFERENCE SPEAKERS

Our luncheon speaker on Saturday will be **Patrick Atkinson of the God's Child Project**. The God's Child Project has been featured on ABC's 20/20. Mr. Atkinson and his organization has received praise from President Obama, the United States Congress as well as several international awards. Mr. Atkinson's presentation will be "Human Trafficking 101" - what it is and isn't. Along with providing a history of human slavery, Mr. Atkinson will lead a discussion on practical steps we can take to combat human trafficking.

Our Saturday evening speaker will be **Janelle Kendall, Stearns County Attorney** (Minnesota). Ms. Kendall will be speaking about her role as the Stearns County Attorney and the creation of the Stearns County Felony Domestic Violence Court. The Stearns County's Felony Domestic Violence Court supervises a core group of the most dangerous repeat felony domestic violence offenders with close judicial and probationary supervision enforced by strict conditions of release, surveillance, weekly offender accountability check-ins directly to the court and utilizing an extended slate of victim support services to enhance victim safety.
